ABOUT NEPENTHES

Tropical pitcher plants, or scientifically known as *Nepenthes*, mostly occur in the Southeast Asia region. There are about 170 species of *Nepenthes* worldwide, 40 species are found in Borneo and 22 species in Sabah. Out of these 22 species, seven are endemic to Sabah, while eight are endemic to Borneo.

ES Endemic to Sabah
(The species can only be found in Sabah)

EB Endemic to Borneo
(The species can only be found in Borneo)

ALTITUDINAL RANGE

HL Highland Vegetation
(The species occurs in montane forests and summit vegetation, above 1000 m a.s.l.)

LW Lowland Vegetation
(The species occurs in lowland vegetation, below 1000 m a.s.l.)

WA Wide Altitudinal Range
(The species occurs in both lowland and highland vegetation)
